



## Dublin City- Well Worth Exploring

- Live Music in Premier Bar every Saturday & Sunday
- Extensive Bar Food Menu available until 9.30pm each evening

- **Bus from outside the door goes to the Parnell Square in the City Centre (10 mins approximately)**
- **Take a stroll around the War Memorial Garden of Remembrance on Parnell Square**



- **Take the City Tour Bus from OConnell Street, as you travel along see the famous Spire, Historical GPO and River Liffey among other things.**

- **Disembark at the Molly Malone Statue for a photo opportunity and take a look around the famous Trinity College where you can wander through. (for a charge you can see the Book of Kells)**



- **Either walk along Nassau Street or hop on the bus to take you the few minutes journey to Merrion Square.**



- **Stroll about the National Art Gallery of Ireland, the National History Museum and take a look at Dail Eireann, the seat of the Irish Government.**



- **Perhaps for lunch a picnic in Merrion Square beautiful gardens may be possible (packed lunches can be purchased from the hotel before departure)**
- *Take a peep into Dublins Georgian past in Number 29 Merrion Square a house which has been restored to its original state (approx €6.00 adults, €3.00 Students and Children)*



- **Hop Back on the bus and continue with the Guided Tour Through Dublin, passing Christchurch and heading towards the Phoenix Park**

- *Take a tour of Christ Church and Dylinia (Viking Dublin), perhaps stay on the bus and save some time for the tour of the world renowned Guinness Storehouse and sample a pint of the Dublin Blackstuff (we can prebook the Storehouse online for you which means you receive a 10% discount)*



- **If you still have the energy, buses from outside the door run regularly to the City Centre, Dublin is a hive of activity at night time.**
- **The Botanic Gardens or Glasnevin Cemetery just five minutes from the hotel.**
- **Alternatively take in the Phoenix Park, home of Uachtarain na H'Eireann, Irelands President, Farmleigh House which is nearby the hotel. (ask at Reception for discount tickets to Dublin Zoo)**
